x Why are these changes occurring?

Indiana Family and Social Services Administration (FSSA) making multi-year reform of its long-term services and supports (LTSS) programs

- Older adults 60 years of age and over
- In the community

Managed Long-Term Services and Supports (MLTSS) program, PathWays for Aging

During Phase 1 Maximus will provide:

- PASRR Level I and Level II
- NF Level of Care (LOC) determinations

During Phase 2 Maximus will provide:

- NF LOC Assessments & Reassessments/renewals
- HCBS Waiver LOC assessments
- Intake Counseling
- Medicaid Application Assistance
- Expanded Helpline Services

Goals of Transformation

FSSA's goals for these services include:

- Use of a strengths-based, personcentered approach
- Assurance of smooth transitions
- Completion of timely and accurate level of care determinations and handoffs



• MCEs will begin submitting LOC screens for persons in the community

• In AssessmentPro

- Aged 60 and older
- PathWays members
- Maximus will complete all needed PASRR activity for this specific population
- Hospitals will submit LOC and PASRR Level I when the person is in the hospital going to NF
- NFs will submit LOC and PASRR Level I for their residents

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

Access Coordinator	 Master user Approves other users within same facility/agency and terminates Assigns roles to other users Search for Members Submit LOC screens 	 Will need to submit Agreement Maximus grants approval Should be the first to register from a facility/agency
MCE	Search for MembersSubmit LOC screens	 Will need this role to view training and submit screens

 - Can have as many as you want, no fewer than 2 per agency
 - No restrictions on who
- 2. Maximus will support registration
 - Registration available 4/8.
 - Complete the form (link in chat) to identify who we should register as Access Coordinators and System Users.
 - Feel free to share the link with team members
- 3. Registration access and process will also be sent as an email

System Roles

AssessmentPro has two role options available to our Managed Care Entity (MCE) partners.

 Access Coordinator - responsible for supporting agency users, assigning roles for agency staff, and maintaining an accurate user list. Can submit level of care screens and access all necessary records for their PathWays members

 Reviewer - can submit level of care screens and access all necessary records for their PathWays members
