<b>Term</b>	<b>Definition</b>
<b>Admitting Facility</b>	The identified nursing facility to which the person intends to be admitted
<b>AssessmentPro</b>	Current vendor (Maximus)'s PASRR web-based submission portal
<b>Civil Commitment</b>	Court ordered involuntary mental health treatment
<b>Clinical Review</b>	All parts of the process for making a determination of the need for a Level II evaluation for all cases where the algorithm was inconclusive. The review is inclusive of requests for additional information from the referral source or other individuals
<b>Community Placement</b>	Any housing situation aside from state center, hospital or nursing facility—this includes, but is not limited to, Assisted Living Facilities, Hospice, group homes, independent living homes, and senior communities
<b>Dual Diagnosis</b>	Mental Illness <i>and</i> Intellectual Disability and/or a Related Condition
<b>Group/Individual In-Reach</b>	Options counseling provided in an individual or group setting in the NF that assists Members interested in transitioning from LTC to a community setting
<b>Health First Colorado</b>	Colorado Medicaid Program
<b>Legal Guardian</b>	The person or entity who is court appointed and legally responsible for decision-making on behalf of an individual.
<b>Level I</b>	PASRR screening tool for persons admitting to Medicaid certified NFs, to identify those who have or may have a known or suspected Serious Mental Illness (SMI), intellectual/Developmental Disability (ID/DD), or Related Condition (RC)
<b>Level I PASRR Clinical Review</b>	All parts of the process from the receipt of the Level I Screen from the referral source to the screening determination of outcome, inclusive of notices of incomplete and/or abandoned screens.

<b>Level II</b>	Completed by Maximus clinical assessor - in-depth PASRR evaluations for persons with a known or suspected Serious Mental Illness (SMI), Intellectual Disability (ID), and/or Related Condition (RC)
<b>Member</b>	Colorado resident with Medicaid
<b>PASRR Related Condition</b>	Mental illness, or an Intellectual or Development Disability or related condition that may require specialized services.
<b>Provider</b>	Health care provider or agency providing medical care or services
<b>PSS</b>	Maximus staff: Project Support Specialist responsible for initiating workflow, referrals to independent contractor assessors, and data entry
<b>QC</b>	Maximus staff: Quality Coordinator responsible for reviewing the clinical elements of the assessment, making determinations, writing summary reports, and completing the workflow process
<b>Qualitrac</b>	Previous Vendor (Telligen's) PASRR Submission Portal
<b>Referral Source</b>	The person/facility/agency who submitted the Level I
<b>Specialized Services</b>	Disability specific services typically exceeding those standardly provided by NF staff
<b>State</b>	The State of Colorado
