Keep in mind that the **MD certification must always match the exemption requested.**

As previously communicated, the **new turnaround time for assessments is 8 hours.**

To ensure federal compliance, SNF should not accept anyone without a PASRR. When someone comes to the SNF with an exemption, **it is best practice to submit a follow-up PASRR screen 10 days prior** to the end of the approval.

To help speed up the review process, we ask that you **upload documents instead of faxing whenever possible.** Additionally, always **double-check that you've filled out the out PASRR/LOC accurately and completely** before submitting.
