BEST PRACTICE: Submitting Necessary Documentation



The Delaware PASRR team reminds Providers to **only submit the documentation that is necessary for the assessment: H&P and MAR**. If a Level II is required, we also request the PAE (completed within the past 30 days) and the most recent psychiatric evaluation. **Submitting extra, unnecessary documentation can slow down the PASRR process and may lead to HIPAA violations**.
