Iowa PASRR Database Change on February 17 May Require User Role Update to Maintain Screen Access and Submissions

An Iowa PASRR Database change is planned for the evening of Tuesday, February 17 that will require some users to update their user roles. Review details below to see if this change will affect you.



What's changing?

Starting Wednesday, February 18, the Master user capacity in the Iowa PASRR Database is sunsetting. This means that system users with **only** the Access Coordinator role will lose the ability to access and submit screens. A second role of clinical or non-clinical user must be added to your profile in the Iowa PASRR Database to maintain this access and ability.

Note: Anyone who has previously selected a second role, such as Clinical User, will not see any changes to their access and will not need to take any action.

What's staying the same?

After this update, Access Coordinators will continue to have the responsibilities to:

- Assign new user roles in the system
- Terminate system users within their facility who should no longer have access to protected health information.

What actions are needed?

Users who only have the Access Coordinator role and want to maintain the ability to access and submit screens will need to select an additional user role.
