- Several Providers have asked how to establish themselves as Access Coordinators in AssessmentPro. <u>Click here to review instructions</u> for adding an Access Coordinator, available via the lowa PASRR Provider Tools & Resource site.
- 2. Assessors now have access to an electronic Release of Information (ROI). Keep in mind that although you are likely to see this version more often in the coming months, Assessors may still provide a paper ROI if they unable to send a digital copy to the Provider. Both versions are still valid.
- 3. Please **submit a recent psychiatric note whenever one is available**, especially if the individual has major mental illness.
- 4. Be on the lookout for information regarding **upcoming in-person spring training sessions**, coming soon to a town near you.

PathTracker+ for Nursing Facility Social Workers, Administrators, & Business Office Staff

Please join us on **Tuesday**, **June 6**, **2023 at 2:00 pm CST**, for an lowa PASRR Technical Assistance webinar, as part of our continuing education series.

This Iowa PASRR Webinar is specifically designed for the staff in your NF who are involved in entering admission, transfer, and discharge information into PathTracker Plus, which is a feature of the Iowa PASRR database.

The webinar will include an overview of several critical functionalities of PathTracker Plus, including the when, where, why, and how to submit admissions, transfer, discharge, and corrected notices, as well as level of care and payment source changes. The use of PathTracker Plus has been mandatory since February 1, 2016, for all nursing facilities in lowa. It is critical that appropriate nursing facility staff are trained and prepared to make necessary entries into the system in a timely manner. It is also critical that the NF stop all use of paper Case Activity Reports, also known as CAR forms, and that ALL changes that would have been submitted using a CAR form prior to 2016, must now be made only in the electronic PathTracker Plus system.

Understanding PASRR Level II Summaries of Findings, PASRR Identified Services, and Implementation

This webinar will demonstrate how to review and understand a PASRR Level II outcome, known as a Summary of Findings, where an individual in the PASRR population is approved for a level of care and services are identified to optimize care and recovery for the individual. There are three types of services that can be identified; including Specialized Services that focus on the PASRR Condition/Disability, Rehabilitative Services that are typically provided as a part of the individual's care in a nursing facility, and Community Placement Supports that help to optimize an individual's potential for successful transition to a lower level of care once they leave a nursing facility for life in the community.

- Review the Level II Summary of Findings (SOF) prior to admission
- Understand the various areas of focus/information within the SOF
- Understand the role of the accepting nursing facility regarding the SOF
- Ensure delivery of all PASRR Identified Services

- Find Care Planning tools to facilitate compliance with service delivery
- Document that PASRR identified Services are being delivered

How to Achieve Compliance during PASRR ServiceMatters Reviews

PASRR Status Changes & When to Complete Them

PASRR & Individuals with History of Child or Dependent Adult Abuse

Please join us on **Tuesday**, **September 19**, **2023**, **at 2:00 p.m. CST** for a webinar that offers an overview of Preadmission Screening and Resident Review - PASRR - and considerations when PASRR is being conducted for someone with a history of Child or Dependent Adult Abuse. PASRR is utilized to identify individuals with serious mental illness, intellectual or developmental disabilities, and related conditions, and identifies services that will be required for them if they enter an lowa nursing facility.

Within the past several years, we have seen a significant increase in the number of PASRR assessments involving individuals with some criminal or child abuse history, or assessments that are conducted while individuals have also been identified as dependent adults by HHS, and where Dependent Adult Abuse assessments are co-occurring with PASRR or have recently been undertaken. In such cases, it is beneficial for the individual and their support network if/when those involved in PASRR can collaborate more effectively with those involved in child or dependent adult abuse assessment, and the service delivery that may follow.

- What information is needed to complete a thorough Level II evaluation and Summary of Findings?
- When PASRR requests Abuse information, what happens with it?

EVENT REMINDER: Powers of Attorney, Legal Guardians and Conservators; Office of the Public Guardian – Two Part Series (Part One) | 2:00 p.m. CST on Tuesday, November 14 and 2:00 p.m. CST on Tuesday, November 28

Please join us for this popular two-part webinar in our lowa PASRR Technical Assistance series. We'll discuss issues surrounding designations of Powers of Attorney for Healthcare and Financial Matters, and when it may be necessary to seek court ordered Legal Guardians and Conservators, how determinations are impacted by the cognitive capacity and the mental health status of the individuals we serve, and many questions that arise as we try to understand the differences, similarities, and implementation issues involved with each type of substitute decision maker.

Information presented in this webinar is expected to be useful to anyone and everyone who works with older adults, dependent adult, persons who may seek placement in any community setting including a

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nursing facility and will not just be of interest to those who work with PASRR. We'll be joined by Jennifer Donovan of the lowa Office of the Public Guardian, who will share her knowledge with us and facilitate better understanding of some of the many issues that frequently arise.

Part 1, which will be held on November 14, will address the important legal differences between Powers of Attorney for Healthcare and Financial matters, Guardianships, Conservatorships, and when each of these may be appropriate for an individual.

Part 2 will review questions that arise in Part 1, and go deeper into issues pertaining to Powers of Attorney, Guardianships and Conservatorships, offering tools and resources that will be very useful to staff who work in hospitals, nursing facilities, adult protective services, and other arenas who may have occasion to help individuals designate Substitute Decision Makers, have a payee, give end of life/care instructions, or may be in need of court appointed guardians and/or conservators.

We hope it will further empower you to help individuals in Iowa enhance their quality of life! The webinar will be moderated by Maximus PASRR Program Manager, Brad Goodin, and Lila Starr, Iowa PASRR Program Manager with HHS.

BEST PRACTICES: Assessment Tips & Reminders

- 1. When submitting a potential status change regarding a new serious mental illness, or other possible changes in PASRR condition(s), you must **include documentation such as the initial or most recent psychiatric evaluation and/or medical notes** with information that includes any new diagnosis and descriptions of current symptoms or issues that led you to believe a significant change in status may have occurred.
- 2. When emailing the Lowa PASRR Help Desk, contacting Maximus or lowa HHS Program Manager, Lila Starr regarding a particular individual, please include the individual's PASRR Individual ID (IID) in the email, if known. This allows us to research the issue and provide a timely resolution in a confidential manner without the need to share identifying information.
- 3. If you are submitting a Level I screen for an individual with any history of court involvement, such as 1) an involuntary mental health commitment for outpatient or inpatient treatment, 2) any type of protective curt orders that may arise as a result of adult protective issues, 3) court orders related to Guardianship of Conservatorship, and/or 4) any potential that the individual have a known history of sexual acting out/aggression, or be a registered sex offender, make certain to note legal involvement on the Level I screen, using the additional text boxes if needed, and submit a copy of all relevant court orders, as part of the Level I submission.
- 4. **Mental health conditions** can only be verified by a provider note, psychiatric evaluation, psychiatric progress note, or other medical record signed by a practitioner/physician.
