Admitting Facility	The identified nursing facility to which the person intends to be admitted	
AssessmentPro	The web-based system that independent contractor assessors use to complete assessments	
Community Placement	Any housing situation aside from hospital or nursing facility—this includes, but is not limited to, Assisted Living Facilities, Hospice, group homes, independent living homes, and senior communities	
Dual Diagnosis	Mental Illness and Intellectual Disability/Related Condition	
IM+CANS	Developed by the Praed Foundation, this is the tool chosen by the State of Illinois to perform a functional assessment for the SMHRF program	
Legal Guardian	The person or entity who is court appointed and legally responsible for decision-making on behalf of an individual.	
Level I	PASRR screening tool for persons admitting to Medicaid certified NFs, who have or may have a known or suspected Serious Mental Illness (SMI), intellectual/Developmental Disability (ID/DD), or Related Condition (RC)	
Level II	Through Maximus, in-depth PASRR evaluations for persons with a known or suspected Serious Mental Illness (SMI)	
PASRR	Preadmission Screening and Resident Review	
Provider	Health care provider or agency providing medical care or services	
PSS	Maximus staff: project support specialist responsible for initiating workflow, referrals to independent contractor assessors, and data entry	
QC	Maximus staff: Quality Coordinator responsible for reviewing the clinical elements of the assessment, making determinations, writing summary reports, and completing the workflow process	
Referral Source	The person/facility/agency who submitted the Level I and/or Level of Care screen	
Specialized Services	Intensive services exceeding those which can be provided by NF staff or rehabilitative services
