NF admission is appropriate for a time-limited period based on medical needs/condition as it is anticipated that the person could discharge within a specified timeframe (approval is short-term and has an end date), specialized services are recommended based on disability-specific needs	<b>Level II-Approved with SS-ST</b> Approved Short Term/time limited stay of _____ based on medical needs/conditions expected: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ 30 days</li> <li>○ 60 days</li> <li>○ 90 days</li> <li>○ 120 days</li> <li>○ 180 days</li> </ul>
NF admission is appropriate based on medical needs/condition, and it is not anticipated that the person could discharge within a specified timeframe (approval is long-term and has no end date), specialized services are recommended based on disability-specific needs	<b>Level II-Approved, with SS</b>
NF admission is not appropriate based on medical needs/condition	<b>Level II-Denied-NF Appropriateness</b>

because medical necessity is not met (DON <29)	
NF admission is not appropriate because it was determined that the person requires a level of service that is more than a NF can provide (person is a danger to self or others, person's needs cannot be safely met in a NF, etc.).	<b>Level II-Denied-NF Appropriateness-Needs Exceed NF Care</b>
After evaluation, it was determined that the person does not have a DD, since the person does not have a PASRR condition, a decision is not required regarding NF admission appropriateness or the need for specialized service	<b>Level II-Excluded from PASRR-No Diagnosis</b>
Level II assessment is no longer needed and has been canceled or withdrawn	<b>Cancelled:</b> <u>(specify reason)</u>

SLP (ISC Outcomes)	AssessmentPro Outcomes
After assessment, it was determined that the person has a DD, <u>and</u> no risks or persistent needs were identified	<b>SLP Appropriate</b>
After assessment, it was determined that the person has a DD <u>but</u> persistent needs and/or risks were identified	<b>SLP Not Appropriate</b>
After assessment, it was determined that the person does not appear to have a DD; since the person does not have a developmental disability, we are not able to assess for SLP admission appropriateness	<b>No DD Diagnosis</b>
SLP assessment is no longer needed and has been canceled or withdrawn	<b>Withdrawn:</b> <u>(specify reason)</u>
