Important Provider Update:

Exempted Hospital Discharge (EHD) Now Active in AssessmentPro

The **Exempted Hospital Discharge (EHD) pathway is now active in AssessmentPro**. This replaces the previously referenced “Limited Time Waiver,” which has been discontinued and should no longer be used.



Providers must use EHD for applicable short-term admissions. EHD may only be used when an individual is admitted directly from an acute inpatient hospital stay. It requires NF services for the same condition treated in the hospital, physician documentation (prior to admission) confirming a stay of 30 days or less, and clinical stability without the need for specialized services.

EHD is limited to a maximum of 30 days. It doesn't apply to ER or observation stays, and requires submission of a Level I PASRR screen. If you have any questions about this process change, please reach out to the [ME PASRR Help Desk](#).
