## **Important Stakeholder Reminders:**

Reconsideration Request Documentation Process | Continued Stay Reviews Best Practices

## PROCESS: Reconsideration Request Documentation



To ensure that your **Reconsideration Request is processed as efficiently as possible**, be sure to follow the guidelines outlines below.

## If requesting a reconsideration, the referral must include:

- · The reconsideration request form;
- Documentation not previously available;
- · Documentation detailing specific changes in the child's behaviors; and
- · Submit the request within 3 business days of receiving the initial denial.

## The Reconsideration Form must be filled out and completed entirely.

Please note, this is only one part of the required information.

**New documentation with new information is required**. This can include recent incidents, reports, clinical notes, assessments, and newly obtained records that were not available or submitted at the time of the original determination. **Submitting only the Reconsideration Form with no new clinical or treatment information will be placed on hold and/or declined.** 

Documents that were previously included and reviewed in the original determination are not accepted. It is recommended that new documentation is recent as well and **describes new behaviors**, **symptoms**, **incidents**, **and similar needs in detail**. Please be sure to submit your Reconsideration Request within the three-business-day window from receipt of the original determination.



REMINDER: TFC CSR Referral Reminder for Human Service Zones, Tribal Partners, and Department of Juvenile Services

When completing a Continued Stay Review ( CSR) referral for TFC, please be sure to mark the appropriate Continued Stay Assessment Type. The child's first Continued Stay Review would be a "Continued Stay Review-6 month," as TFC's effective dates are set for 180 days. If the child has been in a TFC Level of Care for almost 1 year and is being referred to stay in TFC beyond 1 year, the next assessment would be a Continued Stay Review-12 Month.
