BEST PRACTICES: Assessment Tips & Reminders

- 1. Submit all required documents when submitting PASRRs, and requesting Catorgicals and Exemptions, which includes:
 - H&P within a year with the PASRR condition listed
 - Medication list
 - Practitioner Certification form
 - Seven days of nursing notes

We do not need wound care, lab work, x-rays, or documentation from years ago (no excessive documentation of 100 pages or more).

2. Please make sure that your **contact information is accurate** so that we can reach you.






- 1. To prevent delays with PASRR processing and cancellations, be sure to **submit all supporting documentation** at the time the Level I screen is submitted. This includes the most recent H&P within a year, MAR, progress notes, and any additional information to support the Level I screen. **Without all needed documentation**, the **PASRR will be cancelled**.
- 2. If the individual is **no longer at the current location that is listed when then Level I screen is submitted**, please contact the TN PASRR help desk immediately:

- 3. To prevent the PASRR from being cancelled due to being unable to locate the individual, be sure to state whether **the individual is on the confidential list at your facility in the** *notes* **section** of the Level I.
- 4. Please make sure that we have accurate contact information listed for you. Our Independent Contractors will be reaching out to you to schedule the Level II onsite evaluation if a Level II PASRR is needed. We are working within quick turnaround times, and want to prevent any delays with the PASRR process. If we are unable to locate the patient, the PASRR will be cancelled.
- 5. If the PASRR requires a Level of Care screen, please make sure that you submit the PAE Cert form completely filled out and dated within 30 days of the PASRR submission.
- 6. Keep in mind that incorrect demographic information slows the Level I process down. **Always double-check that you have all demographic information correct for the individual**. This includes:
 - First and last name
 - Date of birth
 - Social security number
 - Home address
 - Phone number
 - Current location
 - Payer source

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

- 3. If you discover the individual is no longer at the current location that is listed when then Level I screen is submitted, please contact the **TN PASRR Help Desk** immediately.

Additionally, if an individual is on the **confidential list** at your facility, please let us know that information in the notes section on the Level I screen to prevent the PASRR from being cancelled due to not being





able to locate the individual.
